


Stuffed Animal Zoo
Plans by The Handyman's Daughter™
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Materials - [See tutorial for links](#)

- Two 2x2 boards
- Two 1x3 boards
- 1 3/4" long screws
- Square
- Clamps
- Wood filler
- Paint
- 1/2" diameter screw eyes
- 25 feet of shock cord

Cut List


- 2 x 2 boards cut to 45 1/2" - cut 4
- 1 x 3 boards cut to 18" - cut 4
- 1 x 3 boards cut to 16 1/2" - cut 4

Instructions

Predrill two countersink holes into the ends of the 16 1/2" long 1 x 3 pieces so that the screw heads will rest below the surface. Then attach the 1 x 3 pieces to the 2 x 2 boards with 1 3/4" long screws, making sure everything is square.




Set each side on its edge with the 1 x 3 boards facing outward. Clamp the 18" long 1 x 3s across the top and bottom, then drill a countersink hole in the center of each end. Attach to the 2x2 boards with 1 3/4" screws. Flip it over and attach the other 18" pieces the same way.




Fill the holes with wood filler and sand smooth when dry. Paint the desired color.

Mark the placement of the eye screws on the inside of the 1 x 3 boards 4 1/2" in from each side, and 1 1/4" down from the top. Screw them in until the threads can no longer be seen.

Tie the end of the shock cord to the bottom eye screw, then thread it through the top two and back down to the other bottom eye screw. Tie the shock cord so that the "bars" stay taut, but can pull apart with little effort.



Fill the stuffed animal zoo with fuzzy friends! I recommend putting the largest ones on the bottom and stacking the smaller ones on top.
